

## STANDARD CONDITION OF SUPERVISION

1. Not later than the fifth day of each month, you will make a full and truthful report to your Probation Officer on the form provided for that purpose.
2. You will promptly and truthfully answer all inquiries directed to you by the Court or your Probation Officer. You will allow the Officer to visit your home, your employment site, or elsewhere. You will comply with all the instructions the Officer may give you.
3. You will not change your residence or employment without first obtaining the consent of your Probation Officer. If evicted or terminated, you will notify your Officer within 72 hours of same.
4. You will not leave the area comprised of the county of your residence and adjoining counties without first obtaining the consent of your Probation Officer.
5. You will work faithfully at suitable employment insofar as possible and support any legal dependants to the best of your ability as directed by your Probation Officer.
6. You will not violate any Federal, State, or local penal laws or ordinances. If you are arrested or given notice to appear or citation, you will notify your Probation Officer within 48 hours.
7. You will not knowingly associate with any person engaged in criminal activity.

8. You will not own or possess weapon or firearm.
9. You will not possess or use marijuana or any other controlled substance except upon prescription of a duly licensed medical or osteopathic doctor and then only in accordance with the prescribed dosage.
10. Unless prohibited from consuming alcoholic beverages by a special condition elsewhere in this order, you will not consume alcoholic beverages to the extent that your normal faculties are impaired.
11. You will submit to a reasonable search without a warrant by the Probation Officer of your person, effects, residence, business premises or vehicle for

alcoholic beverages, controlled substances, weapons, or firearms. You will submit to chemical tests (breath, urine, or blood) upon request of your Probation Officer to determine the presence and quantity of alcohol or controlled substances.

12. You will pay to the Department of Corrections the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ per month by the 5<sup>th</sup> day of each month unless other wise waived in compliance with the law.

13. The court retains jurisdiction to place you in the Probation and Restitution Center upon recommendation of your Probation Officer without finding of Violation of Probation.

14. You will pay all monetary obligations remaining from your Probation if not already paid.

**\*\*\* Another frequent requirement that the Judge will add to your probation is compliance with all mental health treatment. You can be violated for not complying with your medications, appointments, and counseling if probation requires it.**
